Code of Conduct for Team Leaders and Team Members

We are committed to the safety and wellbeing of all participants, especially children and vulnerable people involved in programs run by Bray Park Community Church. All Team Members and Team Leaders are required to work within The BPCC Code of Practice which provides essential guidelines for behaviour when working with children and vulnerable people in a program.

The Code of Practice covers;

- Physical Contact
- Program Style
- Cultural Awareness
- Special Needs
- ChildSafe SP3 Ratios
- Privacy & Social Media
- Travel
- Incidents, First Aid & Medication

Recruitment, Selection, Training & Management of Leaders

Our leaders and team members are recruited and selected according to our Child Safety Policy. All leaders and team members are required to hold a valid QLD Blue Card, undergo reference checks and ChildSafe training every 3 years.

Handling Disclosures & Suspicions of Harm

All potential incidents or suspicions of harm will be taken seriously and handled with the interests of the child being the priority. All issues will be handled in accordance with our Child Safety Policy and our Child Harm Abuse and Complaints Policy.

Risk Management

All programs run by Bray Park Community Church involving Children and Vulnerable people will be planned and approved in accordance with our Child Safety Policy. A process of risk assessment and approvals through the ChildSafe Co-ordinators is in place for all programs.
